The attached figures are a selection of figures that depict the ideal points (in three dimensions) of the delegations and most delegates to the Constitutional Convention.

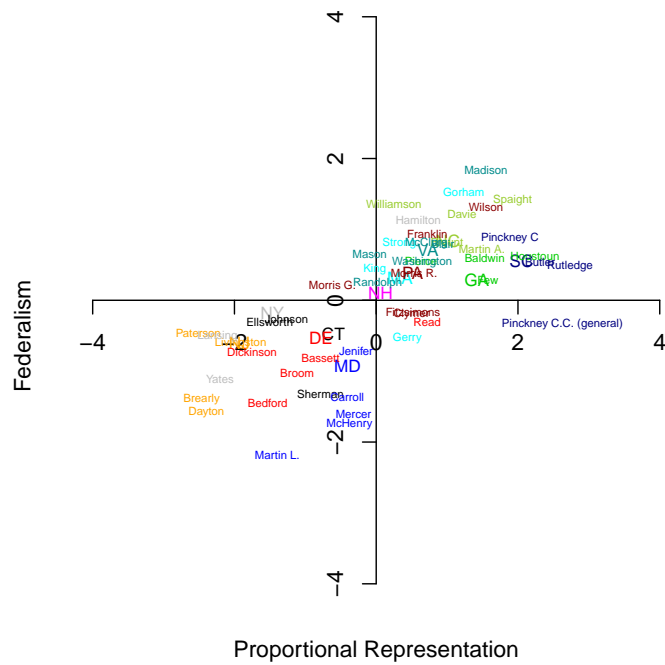


Figure 1: Delegation and delegate positions on proportional representation and federalism dimensions. Note: delegates are color-coded by delegation.

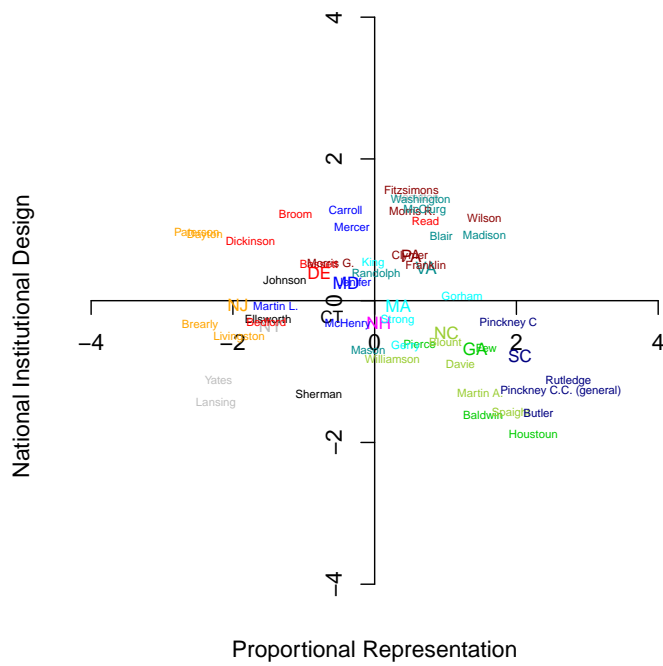


Figure 2: Delegation and delegate positions on proportional representation and national institutional design dimensions. Note: delegates are color-coded by delegation.

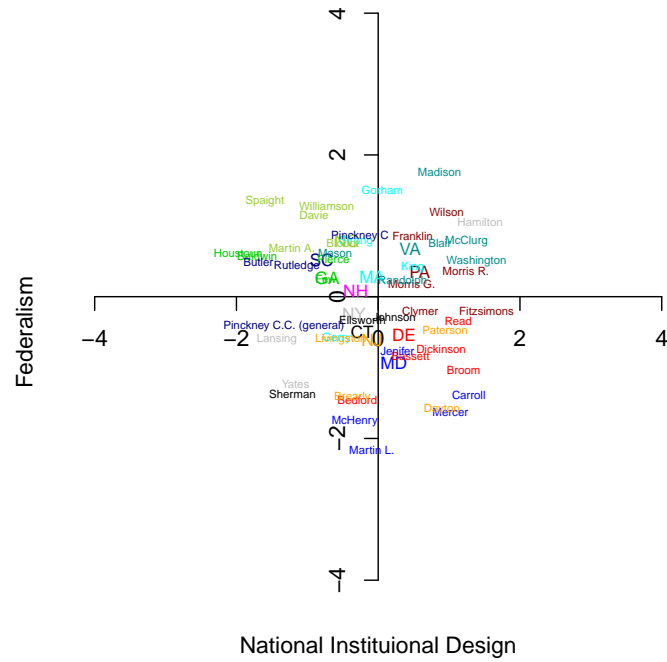


Figure 3: Delegation and delegate positions on federalism and national institutional design dimensions. Note: delegates are color-coded by delegation.

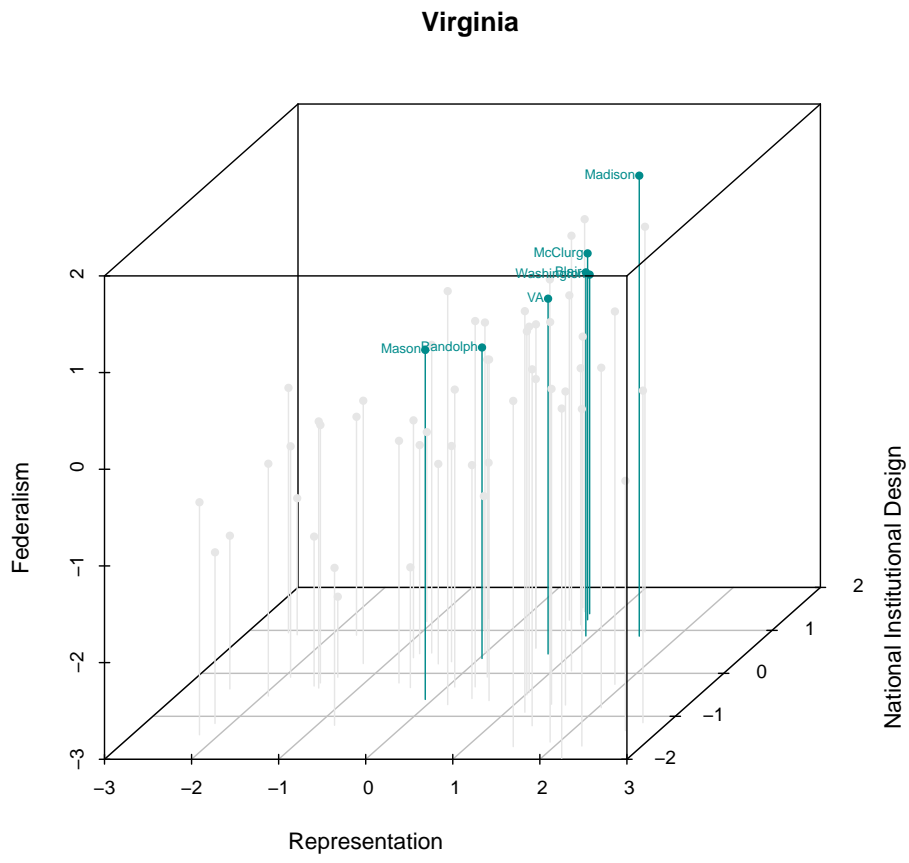


Figure 4: The Virginia Delegation

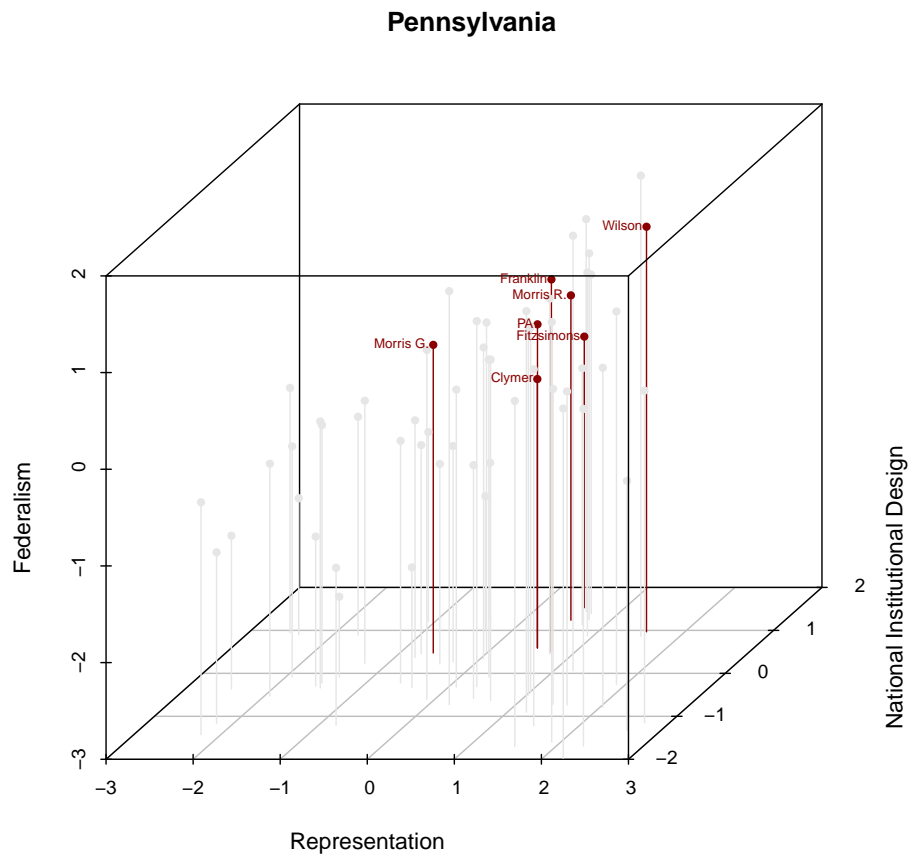


Figure 5: The Pennsylvania Delegation

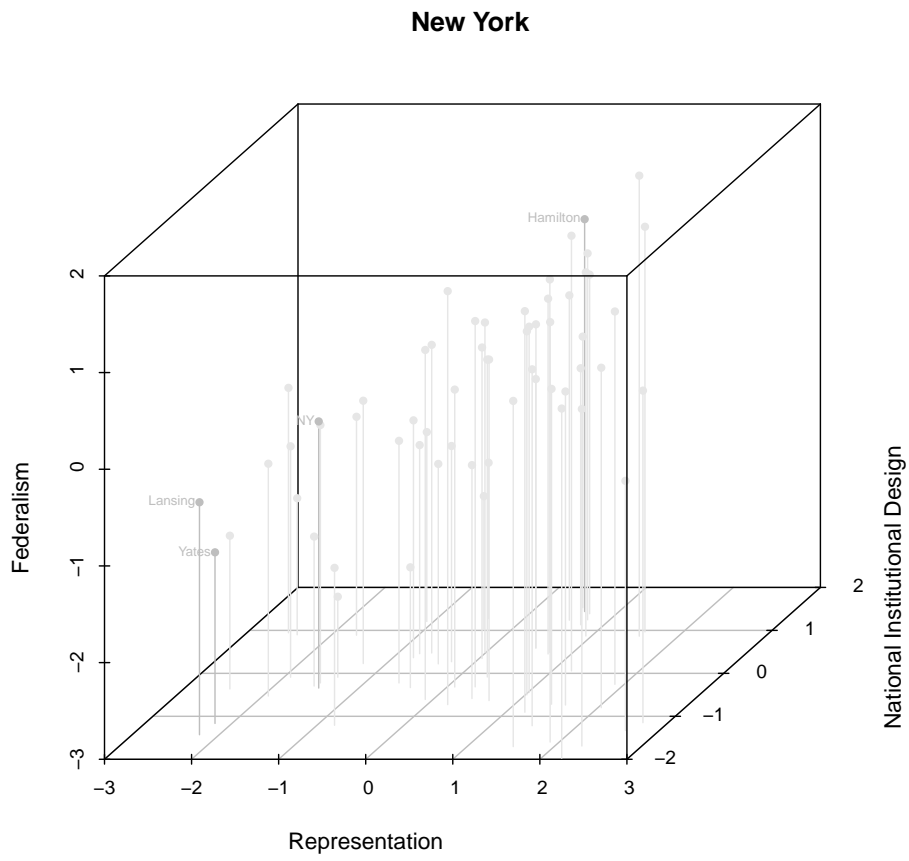


Figure 6: The New York Delegation

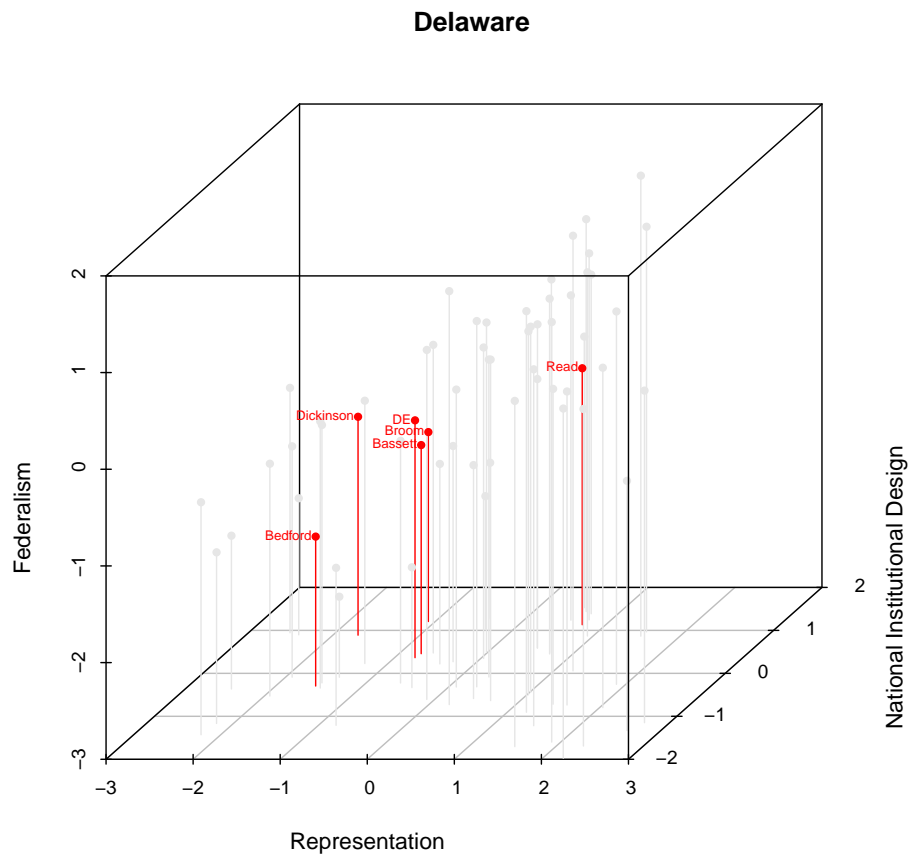


Figure 7: The Delaware Delegation

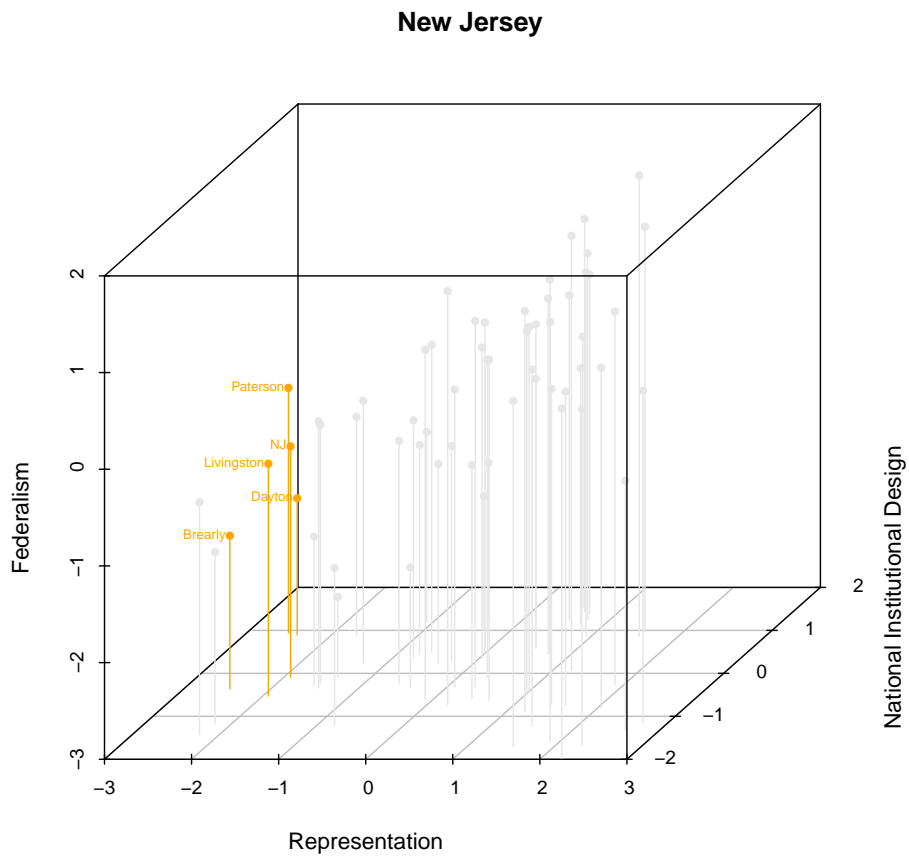


Figure 8: The New Jersey Delegation

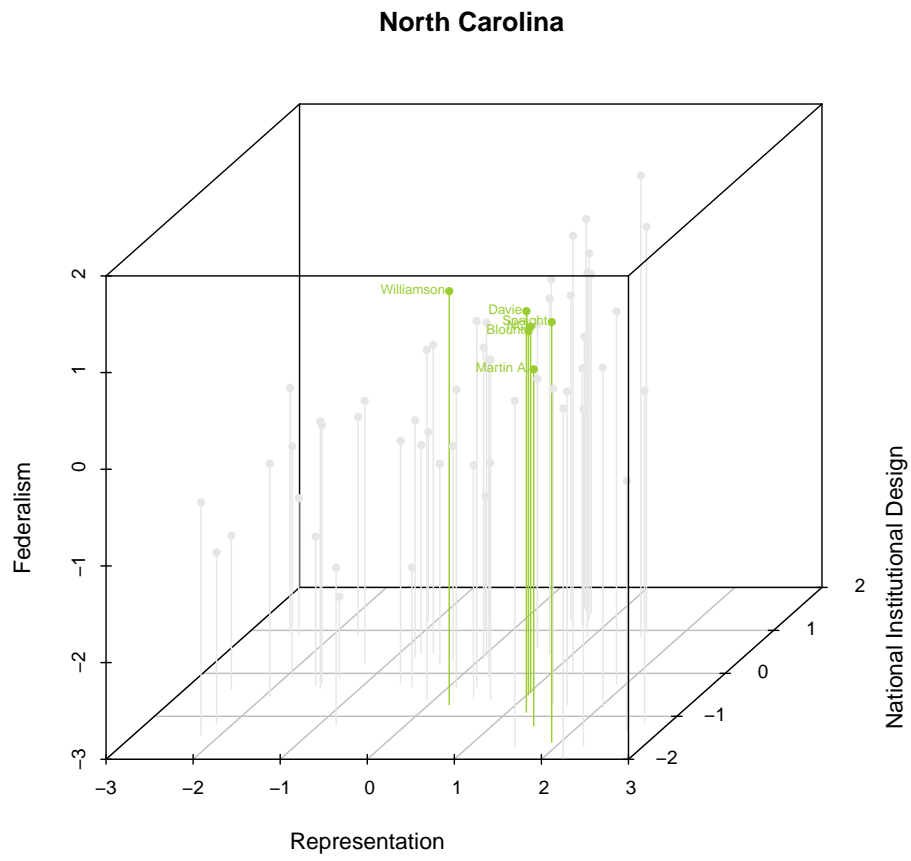


Figure 9: The North Carolina Delegation

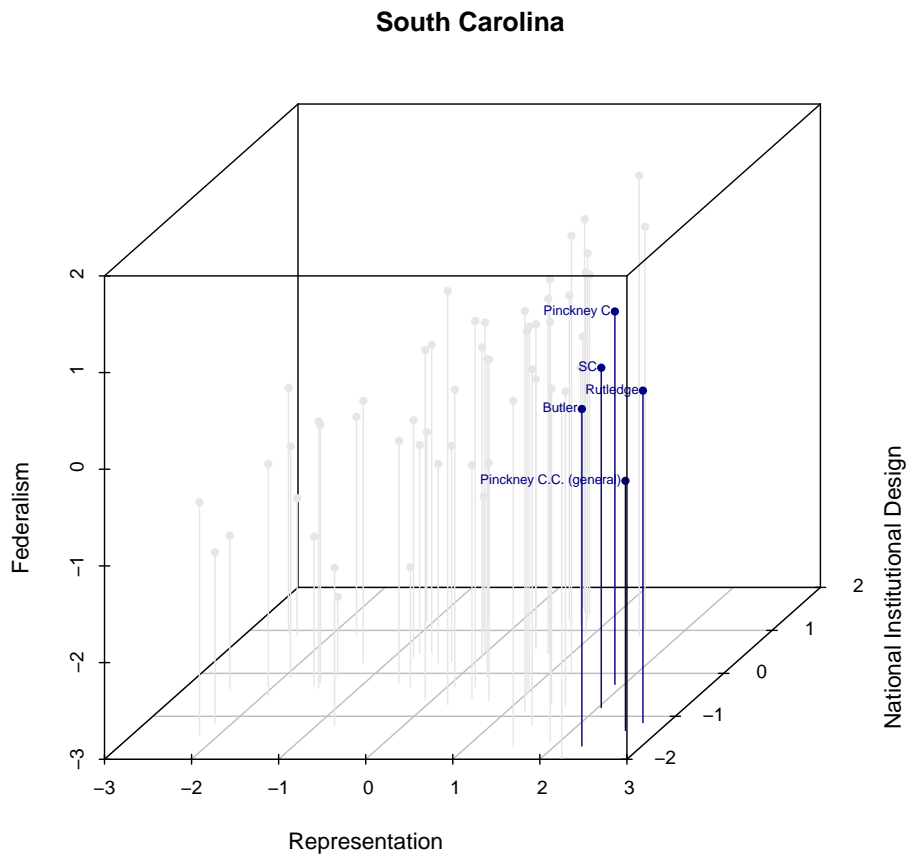


Figure 10: The South Carolina Delegation

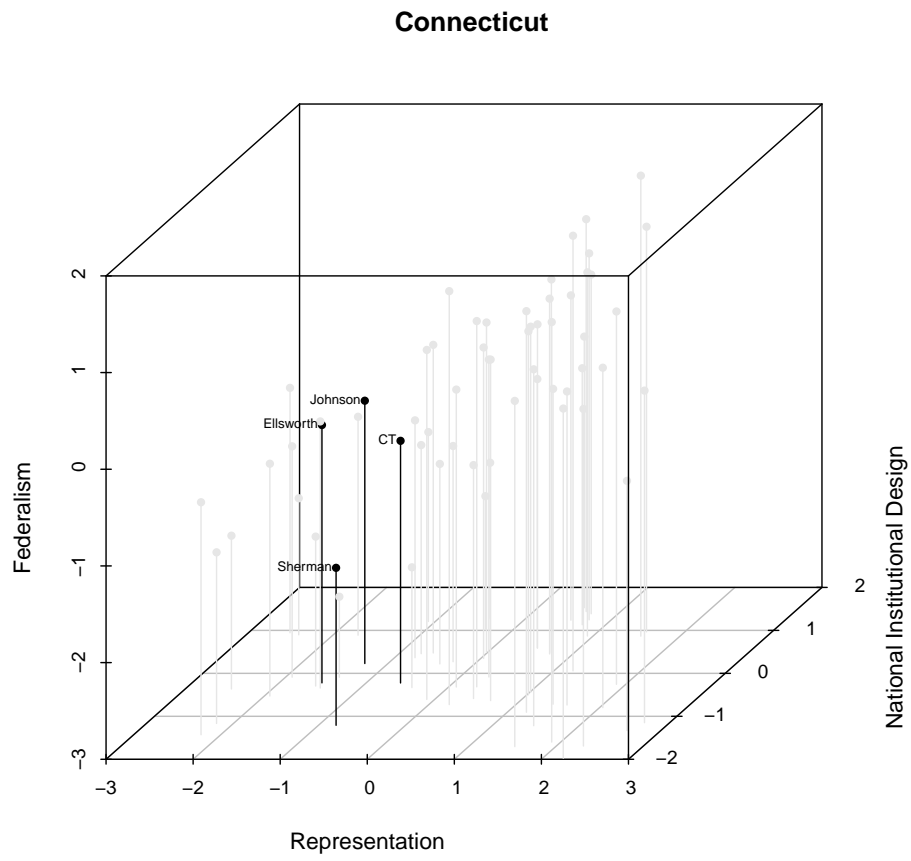


Figure 11: The Connecticut Delegation

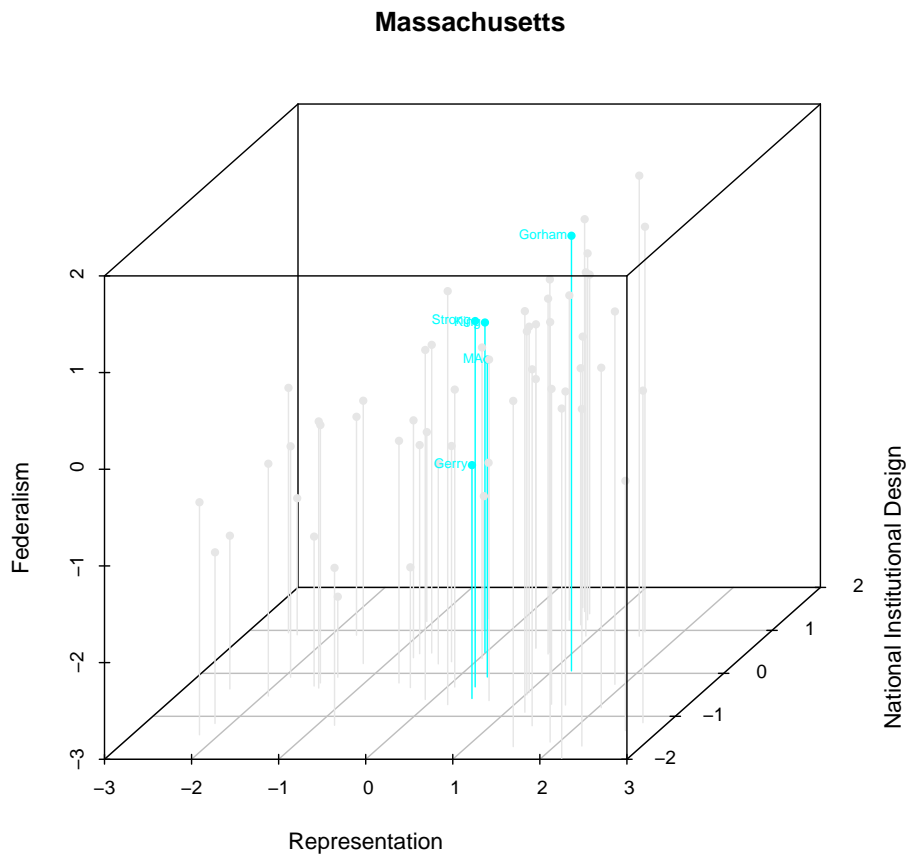


Figure 12: The Massachusetts Delegation

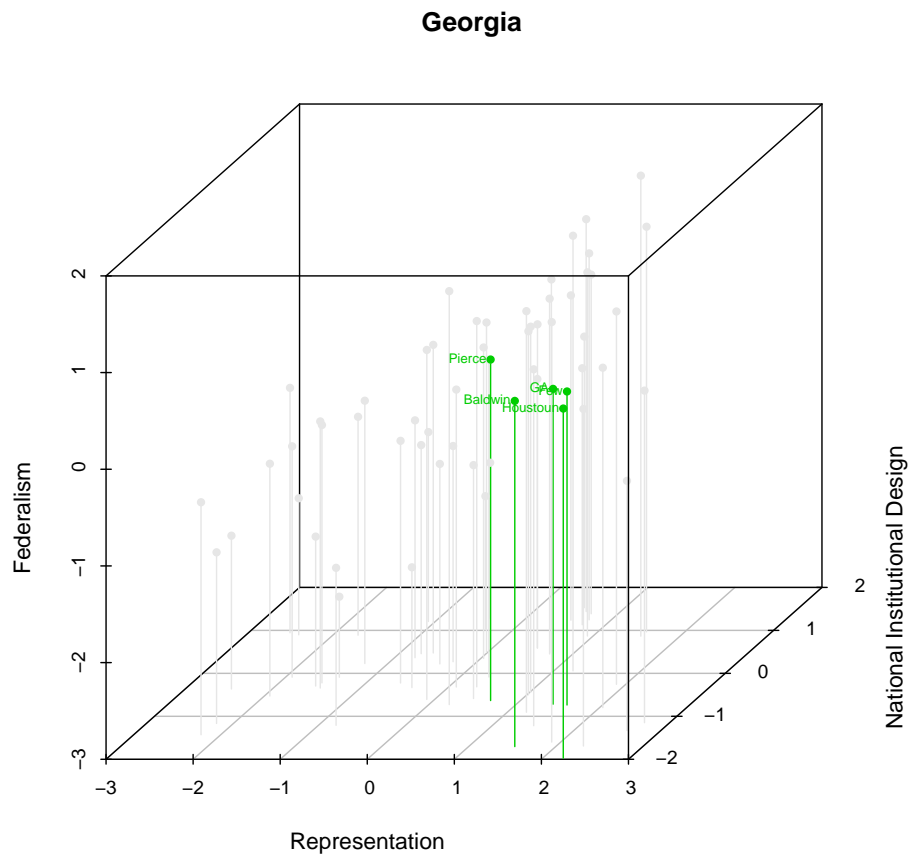


Figure 13: The Georgia Delegation

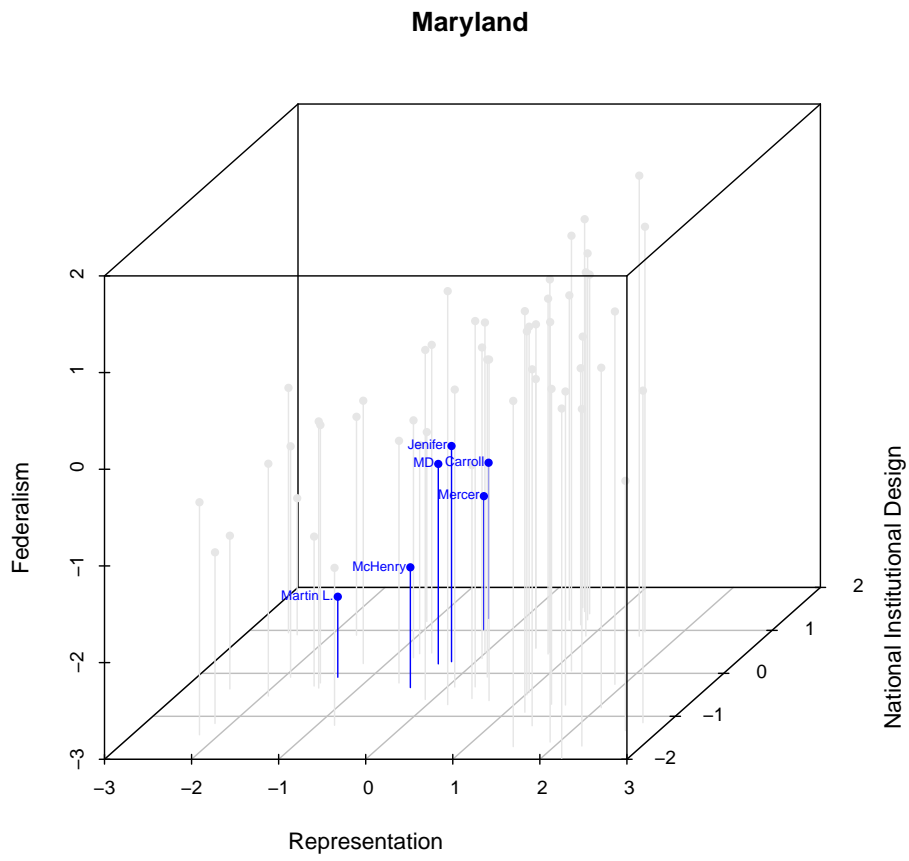


Figure 14: The Delegation

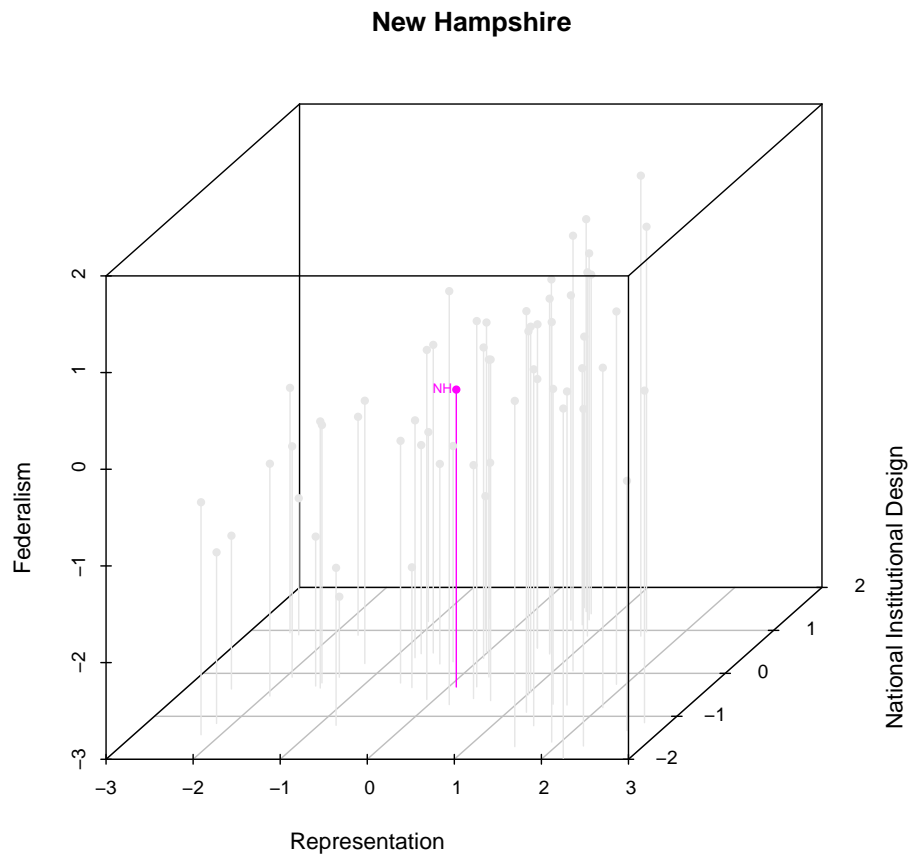


Figure 15: The New Hampshire Delegation
